ARPLEASURE was blocked while trying to split horses midway on the turn, stayed out from the rail into the stretch, angled out and was along in time. REXDALE WARRIOR showed speed from the outset, held a clear lead into deep stretch but couldn't last. YONABREWKA had early position outside, moved to vie three wide on the turn then weakened. KING COMBO was slow from the gate then made up ground outside. ROVE'S BOY angled to the inside while unhurried and lacked a strong closing. RIGHT FLANKER was outrun inside. DR. SEACLIFF dueled two wide to the stretch then tired. ZERO MANNERS was outrun.
