EIGHTY ONE SOUTH moved to the front from the inside after going a furlong, drew out and remained clear under urging. BEE D'OR wasn't far back while saving ground to the stretch, came out from the rail and continued evenly. B. G.'S GEM wasn't far back early, raced three wide around the turn then stopped. S BOX lagged early, came between rivals into the stretch and outfinished tired ones. LAVENDAR LACEWORK saved ground to no avail. PICADDOUBLE came wide into the stretch and failed to menace. U S'S MISS JOYCE showed speed two wide for about a half then stopped. GLORIOUSGAL fell far back.
