MY MCKENZIE set the pace while under pressure through the last turn, then drew off and finished under mild urging. MERRY BERRY was unhurried early, raced two wide on the last turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the winner. SOCIALISTA pressed the pace from the start, raced along the inside on the last turn, then weakened in the lane. MORE AMOUR was close up early, raced four wide on the last turn, then failed to sustain that bid. BABY PULPIT raced two wide through the second turn and was not a factor. SOUTH SEA PEARL stalked the pace from the three path through the far turn then faded. BUBBLEGUM BANDIT prompted the early pace, raced four wide on the last turn, then flattened out in the stretch.
