Footnotes

HEART STRIKER was never far back, raced inside on the turn, then contended in the drive and prevailed. NUMBER UNO LADY set the pace early, drew clear on the turn, then was headed and gave way. DUAL POWER pressed the pace from the inside through the turn then weakened. AURORA RIDGE saved ground then found her best stride late. TIGER DANCER was void of early speed, raced two wide on the turn, then rallied mildly in the lane. GENTLE PERSUASION was close up early, raced three wide on the turn then faded. UNBIASED raced four wide on the turn and failed to menace. GRIZZLY GIRL saved ground but was not a threat. MISS SHE GONE lacked speed, raced three wide on the turn and showed little. BEFITTING stalked the early pace, raced two wide on the turn, then flattened out in the stretch.
