SPIKEAVELLIAN was never far back, raced two wide on the far turn, rallied late and was up in the final strides. OBERWALD pressed the pace from the two path on the last turn, gained command in mid stretch then was outfinished. KLEBER was slow early, raced inside on the second turn, then closed ground willingly. KILLER SPEED saved ground and raced evenly throughout. PHISH was void of early speed, raced three wide on the second turn and made a mild bid. NAVESINK SUNSET set the early pace with a clear lead, was headed on the backstretch, then faded in the stretch. STEAMROLLER BLUES lacked speed and showed little. SHEER WISDOM pressed the early pace, raced along the inside to the second turn, then faltered in the stretch. DUGALD failed to menace. MINOT LIGHT was close up early, raced two wide into the second turn then flattened out.
