B. MURRAY stalked the pace from the two path through the turn, then drew off late under urging. GAARA vied for the early lead, drew clear on the turn then gave way in mid stretch. RICOCHET RABBIT was slow early, raced three wide on the turn then rallied mildly. SEEKING FLIGHT was void of early speed, raced three wide on the turn and found his best stride late. ALWAYS IN LOVE stalked the early pace, raced two wide on the turn, then faded in the stretch. MERRIMACK PAT raced three wide on the turn and failed to menace. BRAVE EMPEROR saved ground but lacked a rally. SWIFT MERCEDES stumbled at the start, raced inside on the turn and was not a threat. WAKI CHEROKEE vied for the early lead, raced inside on the turn, then flattened out late.
