ANYDAY YESTERDAY was unhurried early, saved ground throughout, then rallied from along the rail and prevailed under steady urging. RUN WITH SUE was never far back, raced two wide on the second turn, then gained command in the stretch but was outfinished. SYLVIA'S SWEETART was close up from the start, raced three wide on the last turn, then lacked a late response. ONE SWEET BANKER was slow early, raced two wide on the last turn, then rallied mildly in the drive. SILVER BREW stalked the pace from the two path through the second turn, then weakened late. SASSY DIVA pressed the early pace, gained command nearing the far turn, then faltered late. REAL AMERICAN GIRL set the early pace while under pressure, raced inside on the second turn, then faded in the lane. LADUSKA was close up early, raced inside on the far turn then tired on that turn. LADY MERCEDES was through early and outrun.
