Footnotes

BOCONO pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, was engaged in a long drive and prevailed at the wire. RESPIGHI set the pace and was under pressure from the start, raced along the inside through the turn, then gave way late. PICADILLY PETE was never far back, raced along the two path through the turn, then finished evenly. AMERICAN CAT was close up early, raced along the inside on the turn, then lacked a rally in the drive. SNEAKY DEVIL showed early speed, raced four wide on the turn, then weakened late. FOREIGN OFFICER pressed the pace from the three path through the turn, then faltered late.
