DELIGHTFUL DANA stalked the pace from the three path on the far turn, then drew off in mid stretch while under urging. FULFILLING set the early pace, raced along the inside through the far turn, then weakened in the lane. GRANNY MAC was close up early, raced along the two path and gained command on the second turn, then faded in the drive. BE BEFORE pressed the early pace, saved ground then tired on the second turn. BRITANNIA lacked speed, raced two wide on the far turn and showed little throughout. WICKED PATTY prompted the early pace, raced along the inside on the second turn then flattened out.
