LITTLE PEP stalked the pace from the start, raced two wide and reached contention on the second turn, then drew off in the stretch and finished under mild encouragement. H W GOODIE was unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the winner. PLEASE WAIT was slow early, raced three wide on the last turn, then lacked a late response. KENNEDY was void of early speed, saved ground through the far turn, the found his best stride late. POSTAL SURPRISE set the pace from the start, saved ground then was headed on the last turn and flattened out in the late. FLYBIRD lacked speed, saved ground through the far turn and was outrun.
