STRENGTH wasn't far back, raced the three path around the turn, drifted some in the stretch and drew out under mild urging. HERLUF was forced out at the break then gained late between horses. SCORPIO DOG came out at the break, angled two wide on the turn and improved position outside. MAKE A GRAND stayed out from the rail in good position, lugged in in the stretch and tired. HOT PROPOSITION raced three wide and failed to menace. FLYING VEE was caught wide around the turn and tired. ST. SYLVANS was bumped at the break then was hard used to made the early lead and tired. FORMAL ARGUMENT opened a clear lead soon after the break, angled to the inside and tired. BLUE BULLET was outrun after a slow break.
