**Footnotes**

LADY CIRCLE stalked the pace from the two path through the second turn, then reached contention late and drew off under urging. PRINCESS MAGOGO was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the far turn then angled outward and closed ground willingly. GOLDEN EXPRESS vied for the early lead, then drew off and raced along the inside through the second turn and gave way late. TOP EXCHANGE was close up early, raced inside on the last turn, then lacked a late response. RUN MOMMY RUN was close up and along the inside through the second turn, then weakened in the stretch. BABE'S CHOICE was void of early speed, raced three wide on the second turn and was not a factor. DANCING AT NICKIES vied for the early lead, raced two wide on the second turn then faded. UNBRIDLED PEACE lacked speed, raced two wide on the last turn and was outrun. ALEX'S SIS CASEY pressed the pace early, then the rider's saddle slipped on the backstretch and moved to the outside rail and out of contention.
