RUN NEMO RUN stalked the pace from the two path, then drew off late while under encouragement. CAPTAIN'S BOY was close up and inside on the turn, then angled outward and rallied mildly. LATIN COUNT pressed the pace from the inside through the turn, then failed to sustain a bid. GOLDEN TIE AFFAIR was never far back, raced two wide on the turn and made a mild bid. JOY FROM PHOENIX was slow early, raced two wide on the turn then made a late bid. LIGHT FROST was three wide on the turn and failed to menace. CATCHIN THE REDEYE set the pace early, drew off on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. L'PILOTO raced three wide on the turn and was never a factor. SCULLION was close up early, raced three wide on the turn then faded. BAY SUMMER showed little. SAMPLED JAM pressed the pace from the two path into the turn then flattened out.
