**Footnotes**

COCO POINT steadied in tight between horses on the backstretch and again nearing the stretch, split horses leaving the furlong grounds and took over past midstretch. SUNSHINE PLATINUM was rated in good position, moved three wide to command leaving the turn but couldn't contain the winner. MO BLUES made a run four wide around the turn to be closer into the final furlong but hung. SUGAR FOREST showed speed inside for over five furlongs then tired. ALEXANDRA'S DUE showed speed three wide, moved clear on the turn then tired. MISSION GAP showed speed briefly. DEERSTALKER was outrun. SABATINO was outrun after a slow break. SATURN FIVE stopped inside. WISKAWAY was caught in tight at the break, recovered to duel and was finished before a half.
