**Footnotes**

SOLITARY SUNSHINE stayed outside the early leader, moved to vie on the turn, opened a short lead in early stretch, came in in the final yards and brushed with RIO SAMBA and prevailed after a long hard drive. RIO SAMBA took command at once, stayed inside around the turn, continued with good courage once displaced then drifted out slightly late and brushed with the winner. An objection by Chiappe against the winner was not allowed. BERGKAMP was unhurried inside, angled out on the turn, was widest into the stretch and finished with good energy. ABOVE PAR was brushed on the backstretch then made a run well out from the rail on the turn but failed to sustain through the lane. ADIRONDACK FOREST came out into ABOVE PAR while between horses on the backstretch, raced two wide around the turn then made up ground late. RISE'N REIGN was close up between horses early, angled to the rail on the turn then tired. TOWN SQUARED was slow from the gate, raced the three path and failed to menace. ATLANTIC EXPRESS showed speed briefly inside then stopped.
