Footnotes

RODERICK was rated wide around the first turn, took over entering the backstretch, was clear before a half then widened under steady urging through the lane. GOOD GENERAL was wide while unhurried around the first turn, stayed out from the rail around the final turn and outlasted the others. CRIMSON CHROME lagged early, raced three wide around the final turn and passed tired ones. SPUNK wasn't far back early while racing out from the rail and tired. LITTLE PEP stayed along the rail and failed to menace. CLEARANCE SALE was outrun two wide. ECHSTEIN VILLAGE stayed out from the rail with the early lead, remained prominent to the end of the backstretch then stopped. INDIAN RESERVATION was close briefly while two wide then stopped.
