REDBOARD KING had early position inside, came out three wide nearing the stretch while moving, opened a clear lead entering the final sixteenth then lasted. STRAIGHT THUNDER lagged early, swung widest into the stretch and finished fast to close a gap in the final yards. FOREIGN ARGUMENT moved to vie three wide on the turn then weakened. ACADEMY RUN was bumped leaving the gate, stayed along the rail while moving closer in early stretch but lacked a strong closing response. SNOW MON stayed out from the rail once clear after a quarter then weakened in the lane. TRADE SECRET was caught in tight between horses on the backstretch, swung wide nearing the stretch but lacked a closing response. VILLAGE ROMEO was in tight on the backstretch, was brushed entering the turn and tired.
