MY DEAR BILLY vied for the early lead, drew off on the turn while saving ground and finished under urging. FIVE STAR ERA pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, then was no match for the winner late. THIS BULLS BACK was void of early speed, raced two wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. OATEN vied for the early lead, raced inside through the turn, then weakened in the lane. LOPAKA KEONI was close up early, saved ground on the turn, then lacked a late response. HALO COCO was void of early speed, raced three wide on the turn and was never a threat. NIN'S LAD was close up early, raced three wide on the turn then faded in the stretch. OUR UNCLE PETE raced two wide on the turn and failed to menace. DIMITRAKIS saved ground but was through early. THEGRAYGIGINTHESKY was outrun.
