### Footnotes

LOVELY T was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the last turn then angled outward at the 1/4 pole and rallied in the stretch to draw off while being ridden out to the wire. SIGN OF HOPE was never far back, raced two wide on the last turn and gained command, then gave way late. QUARRY TREMOR pressed the pace from the start, raced three wide on the far turn, then weakened in the stretch. PERFECT SHADOW prompted the pace from the two path through the last turn then faded late. BEACH BADGE set the early pace with a clear lead, raced along the inside on the second turn then faltered. CELESTIAL ACT lacked speed, raced along the two path on the far turn and showed little throughout. NICKEL C was close up early, raced inside on the last turn, then flattened out in the stretch. SEEKING THE CITI was through after a half, raced three wide on the second turn and was outrun.
