DEMOGRAPHIC TREND was never far back, raced two wide on the second turn then angled outward entering the stretch and rallied to prevail at the wire. NESHAMINY set the pace from the start, held a clear lead then was headed on the far turn, entered into a long drive and was outfinished. OPEN REBELLION pressed the pace from the start, raced two wide through the second turn, then weakened late. MESA DRIVE stalked the pace early, raced three wide on the last turn and faltered. SHOOK THE HOOK was close up early, raced along the inside on the far turn and lacked a rally. FOR SCIPION was also close up early, raced along the inside on the second turn, then faded in the drive. WHATTODO WHATTODO lacked speed, raced two wide on the far turn and trailed throughout.
