QUEEN OFTHE CASTLE was unhurried early, moved three wide on the last turn, then wore down rivals in the stretch from the outside while under aggressive encouragement. CALOCAGATHIA pressed the pace from along the inside on the last turn, gained command in the stretch then was outfinished in the final yards. CUVEE MADAME was never far back, raced three wide on the second turn, then made a late bid and weakened in the final yards. BLACK MANDATE was slow early, raced four wide on the far turn, then rallied mildly in the lane. MILLIONDOLLAR DIVA vied for the lead from the start, drew off on the backstretch and saved ground through the second turn then faltered late. ORIENT SKY was void of early speed, raced two wide on the second turn and was not a threat. SO RAVEN prompted the early pace, raced along the inside on the last turn then faded. VINDYS MIGHTY QUIK lacked speed, raced three wide on the far turn and showed little throughout. ALAYSIAH'S GIRL vied for the early lead, raced three wide on the last turn, then flattened out in the stretch.
