### Footnotes

ROVE'S BOY stalked the early leader from the three path, took over in midstretch and held. PHOR PHILIPPE was unhurried, angled out for room leaving the backstretch, was wide into the stretch and finished fastest. UNSUAL MANNER stayed out from the rail while making the way into midstretch then gave way. SPARK PLUG took back from between horses on the backstretch then angled to the inside and continued evenly through the lane. BREEZE KEEPER was put in tight between rivals early on the backstretch, raced wide around the turn and made up some ground. RUNNIN DA FENCES stayed inside and lacked a strong closing. SUNSHINE BROTHER showed speed outside, stayed well out from the rail around the turn then tired. EXILE was outrun.
