Footnotes

PHILHARMONIC was slow early, raced two wide on the turn then angled to the outside and rallied late drawing off under urging. MAGNIFICATION vied for the early lead, raced two wide into the turn and drew clear, then weakened late. A KISS IN THE PARK was void of early speed, saved ground through the turn, then rallied mildly in the lane. DOUBLE DOWN VINMAN vied for the early lead, raced inside through the turn then angled outward at the 1/4 pole and tired late. TRAJECTORY LINE vied for the early lead from between horses, raced inside through the turn then faded in the stretch. COCO POINT trailed the field.
