KINGS TUESDAY was unhurried early, raced two wide and gained command on the far turn then drew clear and finished under steady urging. SILVER BREW pressed the pace from the start, raced four wide on the last turn, then was no match for the winner in the drive. SHE'S STUK UP stalked the pace from along the inside through the far turn, then weakened in the stretch. COMING UP ROSES was slow early, raced two wide on the last turn and failed to menace. SASSY DIVA set the pace with a clear lead from the start, saved ground through the last turn, then flattened out in the stretch. CATAMARAN lacked speed, raced three wide through the second turn and was outrun. MICHELE'S BABY was close up early, raced three wide on the second turn then faltered and was outdistanced.
