POLISH SMILE was caught in tight between horses on the backstretch and turn, split foes to gain command in late stretch and quickly drew clear. JERONIMOS STORM stayed out from the inside while making the way to late stretch then gave way. THAT'S ALL BROTHER wasn't far back inside, moved to vie into the final furlong but hung. DEFREERE TEMPTATION made a run three wide between horses around the turn, loomed a threat into the final furlong but hung. RUN LIGHTENING RUN was slow from the gate, stayed close to the inside while trailing to the stretch then made up ground inside. DIAMOND ROCK had position in the three path to the stretch then weakened. FAST EDDIE was caught wide around the turn and tired. WONGONEWILD was caught in tight between horses on the backstretch and failed to menace. MISIONERO showed speed three wide for about a half then stopped.
