TOPPING moved up inside to gain command on the backstretch, stayed out from the rail around the turn, responded gamely when challenged into the final furlong and edged clear late. ALL SAILS FLYING was unhurried, stayed out from the rail around the turn, angled to the inside in the stretch and gained to the end. IN ORBIT wasn't far back inside, came out from the rail to vie into the final furlong but hung. PHILOMATT was caught wide around the turn while with the pace then weakened. DAITON'S DESTINY was wide around the turn and made up ground late. UNCLE HOWARD had position two wide to the stretch then weakened. CROSSING VERRAZANO was slow to settle, raced two wide and gained too late. BOGOTA BILL was outrun after a slow break. SANDYS GOLD pressed the pace from the three path then tired. WESTERN PIRATE was no factor. DIAMOND TAP stopped.
