TUFFY TOO came in and brushed FLAGERDOWN before going a furlong, was rated outside, vied outside leaving the furlong grounds and drew clear late. Following objections from the riders of the fourth and sixth finishers, TUFFY TOO was disqualified and placed sixth for interference after the break. LADY BARRINGTON bobbled leaving the gate then came out some early on the backstretch, had position out from the rail, vied inside the winner into the final furlong but couldn't keep up late. DURANT'S VILLAGE chased early, moved two wide to command early on the turn then weakened in the lane. FLAGERDOWN stumbled leaving the gate then was bumped soon after, raced wide and lacked a strong closing. SETTAWIG sped clear soon after the break, stayed inside and tired. PROULETTE was bumped early on the backstretch then was no factor. VALL AND JAN was outrun inside.
