NOW AND ZEN stalked the pace, contended from the four path on the turn, then entered into a long drive and prevailed. MR. COMMISSIONER was never far back, raced two wide on the turn, then angled outward and rallied in the lane just missing. OFFICIAL AFFAIR vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then weakened late. NOT MY PROBLEM stalked the pace from the three path, contended on the turn then gave way late. DEANOGUSKA was close up early, raced inside on the turn, then angled outward at the 1/4 pole but lacked a rally. DEMAND A FAVOR raced three wide on the turn and failed to menace. BELIEVE IN LOVE vied for the lead from the inside through the turn, then faltered in the drive.
