DIVI DIVI stalked the pace from the three path on the last turn, contended late then drew clear under urging. MADISON AVENUE pressed the pace from the two path, gained command on the far turn, then was outfinished in the late going. LOVELY AS EVER was close up early, raced two wide on the last turn, then failed to sustain a bid. SIDEWALKING was void of early speed, raced two wide on the second turn, then rallied mildly in the lane. ONE MORE LILLIAN was close up early, raced inside on the far turn, then lacked a late response. HICKORY GRAY set the pace from the start, saved ground on the far turn and gave way thereafter. THE COLOR RED lacked speed and was outrun. TAKE YOUR CHANCES was through early, then pulled up late.
