MARK UP TINY was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then rallied mildly in the lane. OUR BONNIE BRAE vied for the early lead, raced three wide on the turn, then faded in the drive. SILENT SKY vied for the lead from the inside into the turn then faltered. ON A HIGH NOTE trailed the field.
