Footnotes

COOPER JUNIOR was never far back, raced three wide on the turn, then rallied late from the outside and drew off under urging. TIME FOR A WINNER vied for the lead from the inside through the turn, entered into a long drive then was outfinished. TRYAN was slow early, raced three wide on the turn, then closed ground willingly. FEDERAL HILL was close up and inside on the turn, then angled outward in the stretch brushing JOINT ACCOUNT while finishing evenly, after an inquiry by the stewards and an objection, FEDERAL HILL was disqualified from fourth and placed fifth. JOINT ACCOUNT was slow early, raced two wide through the turn, then made a late bid and was brushed in the stretch then gave way. MT. JOY lacked speed, raced four wide on the turn and showed little throughout. FOREST'S VICTORY vied for the lead from the three path through the turn then faded. BAREFOOT BAY vied for the lead from the two path into the turn then flattened out in the lane.
