ANN'S SMART DANCER settled, was sent up two wide on the turn and remained clear for the place under brisk urging. LENAPE RIM was unhurried, came well out from the rail on the turn and continued evenly to be best of the rest. TOP EXCHANGE had early position close to the inside then stopped in the lane. DOWNRIGHT JOYOUS was outrun outside. SISTER ANNIE wasn't far back early while racing out from the rail then stopped. LYNDSEY TOO ducked out at the break then was outrun inside. ECHO CENTER was bumped leaving the gate then trailed.
