CAN YA TRY stalked two wide, was sent clear entering the stretch then widened under steady urging. QUITAKINGSRANSOM was caught wide while unhurried, raced two wide between horses into the stretch, was squeezed approaching the final furlong then finished with good energy between horses. RADNOR ROAD lagged early, raced three wide into the stretch, angled outside and finished with good energy. ZOARES LAND weakened inside. KEY TO THE CITY was wide around both turns and weakened. MINISTERSWILDRIDE was outrun. WILDOMAR SPRINGS had position three wide for over six furlongs then tired. TRASH TO TREASURE angled to the inside while not far back on the first turn, ran out entering the stretch then stopped.
