FRANK THE TANK set the pace from the start, saved ground throughout, and just lasted while under urging. OCEAN NOMAD pressed the pace from the two path, contended late and just missed. CHOPTANK was close up and inside through the last turn, then rallied late and just missed. CHARLOTT HUMOR was slow early, raced two wide on the last turn, then found his best stride late. WHITE BALANCE was close up early, raced four wide on the far turn, then raced evenly. JOHANNESBURG PLACE raced along the inside on the far turn but lacked a rally. GREAT HARBOUR was close up early, raced three wide on last turn then faded. TOM'S TUITION trailed throughout.
