MO BLUES vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then drew off late while under urging. LET THE BELLS RING vied for the lead from the inside through the turn, then gave way late. AUHH MAN was close up and inside on the turn, then lacked a late response. HIGH FAVOR was void of early speed, raced two wide on the turn, then closed ground willingly. BACK ALLEY TALES was never far back, raced two wide on the turn, then made a mild bid in the stretch. THIS BULLS BACK raced along the inside on the turn but lacked a rally. UNUSUAL D J was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then faded in the lane. TOMORROWS DOUBLE showed brief speed, raced three wide on the turn then faltered. KNIGHT'S QUEST lacked speed, raced three wide on the turn, then passed the tired ones. EXCEPTIONTOTHERULE pressed the pace from the three path into the turn then faltered. TUFF HEROES raced along the two path on the turn, was through early and outrun.
