ST JOHN'S GOSPEL stalked the pace from along the inside through the turn, angled outward in the stretch then drew off under urging. COUNT THE GOLD vied for the lead from the inside on the turn, then weakened late. SYLVIA'S FORTE was close up and two wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. THIS BULLS A TRIP raced three wide at the 1/4 pole and made a mild bid late. FRANK THE TANK pressed the pace from the start, raced two wide on the turn, then faded late. JUSTIN M lacked speed and showed little. THIS BULLS BACK failed to menace. RUBI VALENTINO was through early and outrun.
