BROXBOURNE was close up and two wide on the far turn, then angled outward at the top of the stretch and rallied to be up in the final strides. EASTON JACK vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside through the second turn, then drew clear in the stretch but was outfinished at the wire. LAST HEARTBREAKER pressed the pace from the three path through the second turn, then faded late. STRONG RESOLVE vied for the lead from the two path through the far turn, then gave way in mid stretch. CAPTAIN SPITLER raced along the three path on the second turn while trailing the field.
