DEVIL'S WEEKEND vied for the lead from the inside, then drew clear on the turn and finished under left handed urging. ELF LORD pressed the pace early, raced three wide through the turn and evenly throughout. AWESOME PREACHER was slow early, raced four wide on the turn, then closed ground willingly. GAMBINE ROAD was never far back, raced two wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. SUPER HORATIUS vied for the lead early, raced two wide on the turn, then weakened late. EURO GHOST raced three wide on the turn and failed to menace. MEGA ALEXANDRES was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then faded late. TIZ BRIAN lacked speed, raced thee wide on the turn and showed little. QUITE A CHARMER showed brief speed, raced inside on the turn then faltered and was outrun.
