SMOKIN HEART vied for the lead from the two path through the turn then after a long drive prevailed at the wire. SHINE FOR STEVE vied for the lead from along the inside, dueled through the stretch and just missed. HADRIAN'S IMAGE was slow early, raced along the inside through the turn, then closed ground willingly. KING COMBO vied for the early lead, raced two wide on the turn and lacked a late rally. SPIKEAVELLIAN was void of early speed, raced two wide through the turn then made a mild bid. WHO'S BLUFFING raced along the inside on the turn and failed to menace. CLAIM ME PLEASE showed good early speed, raced three wide through the turn then faded. SAWTOOTH MOUNTAIN saved ground but trailed the field.
