ESCORT stalked the pace from the four path through the turn, then drew clear late and finished under urging. TRADE SECRET was unhurried early, raced three wide on the turn then angled to the outside and closed ground willingly. COOPER RIVER was never far back, raced three wide on the turn while racing evenly. WINK AT THE GIRLS was close up early, raced four wide and reached contention on the turn the faded late. TOMORROW'S TALE pressed the early pace, raced along the inside on the turn then angled outward but lacked a rally. HELPING HAND trailed to mid stretch, raced along the two path on the turn, then passed the tired ones. ANDIE OATLEY vied for the lead from the three path through the turn, then faltered in the stretch. CHRISTMAS FLYS vied for the early lead, raced two wide on the turn, then tired in the stretch. RED PETE vied for the early lead from along the inside, then faded on the turn and was outrun.
