#### Footnotes

BAREFOOT LANDING was unhurried early, raced three wide and contended on the last turn, then drew off and just lasted while under urging, an objection was lodged by the rider of CREW for interference in the vicinity of the 3/8 pole, after review the stewards' saw no cause for disqualification. AWESOME CHARLIE was close up from the start, saved ground on the second turn, then rallied late and just missed. CREW raced in the second flight down the backstretch, was three wide on the far turn then made a late bid to finish well. DRAYTON HALL was void of early speed, saved ground on the last turn then angled outward and closed ground willingly. LUCKMAN was slow early, raced four wide on the second turn then rallied late but weakened. NIGHTSCAPE saved ground on the last turn but failed to menace. S W AIDAN pressed the pace from the start, saved ground and contended on the last turn, then faded in the lane. MYRASIRA set the pace from the start, raced two wide and was headed on the backstretch, then faltered on the last turn. YANKYSJAZZ pressed the early pace, reached contention on the backstretch, then entered into a long drive and flattened out.
