EASTER GIFT was well positioned early, raced two wide on the far turn then moved to the outside and contended then drew off under encouragement. NORMAN ASBJORNSON stalked the pace from the three path and reached contention on the far turn, then entered into a long drive and gave way late. PANTS ON FIRE vied for the lead from the two path through the second turn, then weakened in the stretch. MACHO MACHO was unhurried early, raced inside through the last turn, then found his best stride late. RATTLESNAKE BRIDGE vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside through the far turn, then faltered in the drive. JIMANATOR was close up early, raced three wide on the second turn, then lacked a rally. GREAT INVESTMENT was close early, raced four wide throughout, then faltered in the drive. ADIRONDACK KING prompted the early pace, raced along the inside on the last turn then was outrun in the lane.
