TALKIN TO AN ANGEL was bumped after the break, moved to press the early leader from between rivals soon after, raced two wide around the turn, drew even in early stretch and prevailed at the end of a long hard drive. SILVER SPEED was caught in tight while showing speed between rivals after the break, took over nearing the end of the backstretch, responded gamely when challenged in early stretch but bore out under left hand whip and was outfinished. WESTERN GLITTER was slow leaving the gate, rallied closer along the rail in early stretch but couldn't gain to the end. TIME TO JAZZ advanced three wide on the turn, drew clear on the outside before a half then flattened out. FAST ADVICE stayed inside and lacked a closing response. BRIGHT BRIANA showed early speed outside then tired. TWO BOWS was outrun. VITRIFY showed early speed outside the winner, bore out on the turn and stopped. PROPER GUN trailed after a slow break.
