**Footnotes**

HOPPER vied for the lead from the start, raced four wide on the turn, then drew off in the stretch while under urging. HIGH BAR vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then gave way and was no match for the winner. PETIONVILLE'SDREAM vied for the lead from the three path through the turn, then weakened in the stretch. IRONHEAD vied for the lead from between horses on the turn, dropped back at the 1/4 pole then angled outward in the stretch while fading. HOLY MIRACLE was close up early, saved ground on the turn, then lacked a late response. STORMING WOLF broke slowly, saved ground on the turn, then trailed throughout.
