BISCUIT SNATCHER was unhurried early, rallied four wide around the final turn, finished fast outside and ran clear at the end. DEERSTALKER wasn't far back inside, moved to vie on the final turn, took over in early stretch then couldn't withstand the winner. VEGAS PLAYER moved to vie three wide on the final turn then faltered. SUNDAY SPICE stayed out from the inside with the early lead then weakened. ONE LESS AFFAIR found best stride too late. PEPPERMONT wasn't far back early while wide around the first turn, moved wide to vie on the final turn then flattened out. MO THAN ENOUGH stayed inside and tired. DOS PARTNERS was outrun. BLUEWATER CAT was wide around the first turn while in good position then stopped. PRINCE OF MINE stopped.
