JAZZ SEEKER stalked the pace from the two path through the turn, then angled to the rail and rallied and was up in the final strides. PAPALEO was close up and inside on the turn, raced to contention in mid stretch then was outfinished. SAYERS set the pace from the start, saved ground on the turn, then gave way late. J T MORGAN was never far back, raced three wide on the turn, then made a late bid but tired. WILD INQUIRY pressed the early pace, raced two wide on the turn then weakened in the stretch. WOOD ALLEY lacked speed, saved ground on the turn and was outrun. FOXY LION pressed the pace from the three path through the turn, then pulled up in mid stretch and was vanned off.
