CRIMSON SUN was rated early, stayed close to the rail around the turn, swung out entering the stretch, took over entering the final sixteenth and held. GENERALISSIMO was unhurried inside then came out for the drive and finished with good energy between horses. MY BEST PAL RED raced two wide into the stretch, angled out and finished fastest. BACKBACKBACKGONE dueled two wide and gave way past midstretch. VAN LEROY raced two wide and gained mildly. UNSUAL MANNER dueled inside for about a half then tired. WHITE RUSSIAN was outrun after a slow break. ADAM'S NAY hesitated at the break then trailed.
