SPARKLIN SILVER was never far from the lead, raced along the inside approaching the turn, then angled to the outside in mid turn and rallied late to wear down rivals in the drive. HARRYSGIRLSALLY set the pace from along the inside, was under pressure throughout and was outfinished in the final yards. GOT LUCK was close up, raced three wide on the turn and closed willingly. KAN MOVE showed good early speed, saved ground on the turn but failed to sustain her bid. A CUT OF SUNNY stalked the pace from the start, raced three wide on the turn, then faltered late. BROADWAY'S NIECE trailed into the turn, raced along the three path and made a mild bid. SNAPPY COPELAN pressed the pace from along the inside on the turn, but lacked a late response. GHAZI'S JULEP saved ground but lacked speed. SCAT SINGER was close up early, was four wide on the turn and was outrun late.
