Footnotes

DURANT'S VILLAGE showed speed from the outset, moved clear into the turn and was under brisk urging. MISS WILKO had early position two wide then weakened in the lane while second best. DICTATE THE TERMS bobbled leaving the gate then was unhurried, rallied five wide around the turn to get closer then flattened out. PROULETTE was bumped after the break then was caught in tight between rivals on the backstretch, raced three wide around the turn and tired. TUNES COMPANION moved up between rivals on the backstretch, angled to the rail on the turn then stopped. ANGELICA FUSSY passed tired ones. ARTIST'S VISION wasn't far back four wide into the turn then stopped. COME WHAT MAY was caught in tight along the rail into the turn, came out between rivals and failed to menace. WHISPERING PRIDE was outrun after a slow break. ANCILLA dueled inside to the turn then stopped.
