Footnotes

YANO was rated in good position while in a bit tight into the turn, angled wide for room while commencing a rally approaching the stretch, took over entering the final furlong and edged clear. AZICHARMYOU was squeezed between horses leaving the gate then was unhurried outside, made a wide run around the turn, closed outside the winner through the lane but couldn't keep up late. BRAULIO was squeezed at the break then was unhurried, rallied wide into the stretch but couldn't gain. BEAR'S PROSPECTOR broke in the air then was caught in tight between rivals soon after, was caught in tight nearing the turn and weakened. ACADEMY RUN raced three wide with the leaders to the stretch then tired. CHAC MOOL made the pace inside to the stretch then tired. MR. BARRACUDA came in after the break then raced two wide with the pace to the stretch and tired. MAINE INGREDIENT came out at the break then was outrun.
